Charlie Stimson: Powerful striker who started his footballing career at Tottenham Hotspur academy and then moved to Gillingham FC for 2 seasons. Then spent time at Barnet and Tooting and Mitcham, then moved to Thurrock FC where he spent 6 seasons scoring goals. Joined Waltham Abbey at the beginning of the 18/19 season.

Ronnie Winn: A hard working striker who started at Millwall for a couple of seasons and then moved to Canvey Island where he played for the youth structure. Moved onto Thurrock FC where he progressed from youth into men's football and has flourished ever since. Joined Waltham Abbey at the beginning of the 18/19 season.

George Winn: This Defender with pace started at Redbridge as a teenager and then joined his brother at Canvey Island for a couple of seasons. Moved onto Thurrock FC where he progressed from youth into men's football and has flourished ever since. Joined Waltham Abbey at the beginning of the 18/19 season.

Jeff Okirie: Jeff is a young striker who has spent time at Southend Manor and played in Cyprus for a couple of seasons. Joined Waltham Abbey at the beginning of the 18/19 season.

Joe Christou: Midfielder with energy, Joe was at Leyton Orient until 16 years old. Came through the ranks at Tilbury, joined Hornchurch for a short spell before joining Thurrock FC for a couple of seasons. Joined East Thurrock Fc for the second half of last season before reuniting with Mark Stimson here at the beginning of 18/18 season.

Ricky Brennan: Ricky is a defender who started at Biggleswade town, then moved to Chesham Utd to make his break through into men's first team football. After 2 seasons, moved to London Colney where he won the league. At the start of 17/18 season, joined Cheshunt FC where he moved to Waltham Abbey at the turn of the year. Retained for the season 18/19 under the new management team.

James Coppin: Young midfielder who has had spells at Faversham, Sevenoaks and Thurrock FC where he won reserve league titles. Moved to Southend Manor with current reserve team management and signed for Waltham Abbey at the beginning of the 18/19 season.

Greig Stewart: A midfielder who started at Tottenham Hotspur U13's and moved to Charlton when he was 15. At 19, got the call to represent Scotland at that age level. Since then, he has spent time with Thurrock FC and signed for Waltham Abbey at the beginning of the 18/19 season.

Nathan Okoye: A Young defender who started at Cardiff City academy, played in Finland and was at Crawley Town at the beginning of 17/18 season. Finished the season helping Romford make their escape from relegation in the Bostik North. Joined Waltham Abbey at the beginning of the 18/19 season.

Michael Pindy: A former Abbott and pacey Midfielder, "Pindy" started at Great Wakering and moved to The Abbotts for a season. Spent time at Aveley FC, Thurrock FC and Barking before signing for Waltham Abbey at the beginning of the 18/19 season.

Billy Holland: A vastly experienced midfielder who has spent time across the footballing spectrum. Played for Hornchurch, Maldon, Billericay, Aveley before heading "home" to The Abbotts. Retained by the new management at the beginning of the 18/19 season.

Ellis Brown: A Midfielder with over 10 years' experience at Charlton FC before signing pro forms at Southend for one season. Played at Tonbridge Angels, Mertsam, Dartford, Thamesmead, VCD, and Thurrock last season before joining Waltham Abbey at the beginning of the 18/19 season.

Tim Ogunrinde: A young, versatile midfielder who has spent his time progressing through the ranks at Thurrock FC. Broke through into the first team whilst they were in the Bostik Prem in the 17/18 season. Joined Waltham Abbey at the beginning of the 18/19 season.

lby Kehinde: Another young striker who has spent time coming through the ranks at teams like ottenham Hotspur, Barnet, and Stevenage. Has played for Nigeria at Under 15 level and signed for Waltham Abbey at the beginning of the 18/19 season.

Rimmel Daniels: Rimmel has played for the likes of Leyton Orient and Gillingham where he played under Mark Stimson. Once turning out for Grenada, Rimmel spent time with Hornchurch before signing for Waltham Abbey for the 16/17 season. Retained by the new management for the 18/19 season.

Reece Morgan: Reece is a defender who started his career at Heybridge Swifts before joining Thurrock fc. Joined Waltham Abbey at the beginning of the 18/19 season.

Rob Clark: A midfielder who is a Thurrock FC youth product who came through the ranks to break through into the first team in 2015. Had a season at Basildon before a major knee operation kept him out of the game for a year. Joined Waltham Abbey at the beginning of the 18/19 season.

Arthur Janata: Goal Keeper who is a youth product of Leyton Orient and joined the academy at the age of 8. Arthur has been there ever since and now in his 3rd Year scholarship, he joins Waltham Abbey on loan.

James Goode: James is a midfielder who played for Millwall from U8's to U16's before being released and joining Maidstone whilst at Thurrock football college. He made his break through from there into the first team and spent 4 seasons with them. Joined Waltham Abbey at the beginning of the 18/19 season.
